Nine Across/Down answers containing a consecutive repeated string of two or more letters (e.g. <u>BARBARIC</u>) should be entered with only one instance of those letters to form a new word (e.g. as <u>BARIC</u>), resulting in seven empty squares in the completed grid. Enumerations refer to available spaces in the grid. An extra letter in nine other Across/Down clues explain what each of these entries represents, and what they do.

Answers to "Other" clues must have a letter removed (leaving non-words) and then be located in the completed grid (one dropped letter is ambiguous, but is resolved by the endgame). Each one passes through an empty square. Letters in these squares provide a phenomenon, while letters that were removed provide a key feature of this phenomenon.

Solvers should replace a section of the grid with this feature's name and highlight an appropriate individual who will be revealed. Finally, solvers should connect nine points of interest with nine straight lines, creating a depiction of the feature.

The spelling of 19A is in Collins. One answer is an abbreviation.
